

A Typical Day at Summer Camp (Ages 3 to 7)



Here's a general structure of our daily camp schedule. Depending on camper interests or weather this is subject to change. The times listed are approximate, and quite often activities will last longer or shorter than listed.

Typical Half Day (9:00- 12:00)

9:00 – kids arrive
9:00- 9:15- settle in, free play inside
9:15- first activity outside
9:45- second activity outside
10:30- snack
10:45- third activity
11:30- song circle
12:00- departure

Typical Full Day (9:00-3:30)

9:00 – kids arrive
9:00- 9:15- settle in, free play inside
9:15- first activity outside
9:45- second activity outside
10:30- snack
10:45- third activity
11:30- song circle
12:00- lunch
12:45- fourth activity
1:30- fifth activity
2:30- snack
3:00- closing activity/ song circle
3:30- departure

Activities vary daily depending on ages and are aligned with weekly camp-wide themes. Sample activities include a wide array of fun and learning catered to the interest and needs of each camp group. Below are some typical activities that can be expected from each camp group.

Age 3 (counselor to camper ratio of 1:6 or less)

woods hike, large motor games, pond stomping, bug searches, natural art, story time and animal presentations

Age 4-5 (counselor to camper ratio of 1:8 or less)

animal themed games, gardening, animal shows, pond exploration, forest exploration, baking and natural art activities

Ages 6-7 (counselor to camper ratio of 1:8 or less)

bird watching, silly group games, pond study, natural art, building shelters, animal presentation, natural tie dye, animal games, gardening, composting and scavenger hunts
