

## Photograph Release Waiver

Photograph, Website, Publications, Advertising: I hereby give permission for my child's photo to be taken during camp hours to be used by New Canaan Nature Center for the above mentioned promotions. If I disagree, I will notify the Camp Director immediately.

Session Changes: After original registration is processed, a fee of \$25 per camper will be assessed for all changes.

Age/Toilet Training Requirements for Registration: All campers must be at least 3 years old by June 1st and be fully toilet trained/able to use bathroom independently prior to first day of camp.

Registration Forms: Forms are processed in the order received. If a session is full, registration will be placed on hold and you will be notified to discuss alternatives. Wait list, etc... No weeks will be pro-rated and partial payments are not accepted. Camp Registration CLOSSES at the end of business day (Thursday), prior to each camp week.

Camper Forms: All forms can be found on New Canaan Nature Center website.

Connecticut State Law: Campers may not attend camp without all necessary completed health and information forms on file prior to the start of camp.

Emergencies, Medial Conditions, Aides & Other Considerations: If a camper requires any special accommodations (e.g. major allergy, aides, medical conditions, etc.), the Camp Director must be contacted at least 2-4 weeks in advance.

In the Event of an Emergency I give permission for and understand all of the following:

Every effort will be made to reach me an/or a listed emergency contact. New Canaan Nature Center staff may administer first aid/medical/allergy treatment/if applicable, to my child/My child may self administer prescribed medication/All per Medication Administration Form.

**If necessary, my child may be transported to the most readily available hospital. Hospitalization/Secure proper treatment/injection/anesthesia/surgery will be administered if necessary. I am responsible for all cost incurred for transportation/treatment.**

Health & Safety: According to CT Department of Public Health, campers appearing to have contagious disease must be quarantined and sent home. New Canaan Nature Center reserves the right to restrict enrollment/participation, in the event that participation in camp is deemed unsafe/unsuitable for a child by New Canaan Nature staff, either for the safety/experience of the child or for the safety/experience of the staff/other campers. New Canaan practices a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY FOR HITTING. Campers who strike other campers or counselors will be sent home.
