



Little Explorers – Summer 2025

A caregiver and child program

An introduction for young children to the natural world around us. Children and caregivers will explore the great outdoors and discover all the natural wonders mother nature has to offer.

Little Explorers is a Caregiver and Child program that meets one day per week and is designed for children aged 18 to 36 months old. The program provides important socialization and acclimates children to a group setting.

Little Explorers will spend most of the class exploring outdoors. *We expect to walk in all puddles!* We will be feeding chickens, walking in the woods, playing in the river, and digging for worms. Little Explorers teachers will read stories, sing songs together, and dance. We will visit the animals in the Visitor Center as well as the Birds of Prey.

Please bring a water bottle along (no juice). Little Explorers should have sunscreen and bug repellent applied prior to class. We will all have the same snack provided in class. Please advise the teacher if your child has an allergy.
